Delhi Connectivity

New Delhi, the capital of India is well connected to the rest of country by air, rail and road transport. The Railway Stations and Airports in Delhi are well equipped with the facility to hire pre-paid taxis for which the participants are requested to reach to the designated place within the Railway Station or Airports. Assistance/International Tourist Books are available there.

The participants also can make use of Radio Phone Cars by dialing 91+11-44224422 (meru cab), 91+11-41414141 (mega cabs), 91+11-45333333 (quick cabs). The tariff of the city radio taxi is fixed by the Government of Delhi. Mileage is determined by using tamper proof electronic fare meters - no hidden costs or overcharging. You are charged only from origin to destination i.e. pick up point to drop point. Night Surcharge of 25% levied between 2300 hrs to 0500 hrs.

Local Transportation Within City

Delhi is widely connected with Metro Rail and one can reach the Conference Venue by using the Metro Rail. Please visit the web site: <http://www.delhimetrorail.com> for more details. The nearest metro station for INDIA HABITAT CENTRE is JORBAGH on the yellow metro line and JAWAHARLAL NEHRU STADIUM metro station on the violet line. The Jorbagh Metro station is about half a kilometre & Jawaharlal stadium station about 1.3 km from the venue.

Delhi also has a also fairly good number of local taxis and autos. The participants are advised to be careful about the fare charged. If you are familiar with the city you can avail the local bus transport facility which runs a large number of AC buses on all local routes.

November is the beginning of the winter season in Delhi and is pleasant. The maximum temperature in the afternoon would be about 25° to 30°C and the minimum would fall to about 15°C.
